



HYDERABAD ROCKATHON 2022 – Ending the year on a rocking note!




The 9th Hyderabad Rockathon had all the highs of the previous 8 editions with an enthusiastic audience of 200 participants. Held at Ghar-e-Mubarak on 4th December, the event jointly organized by the Great Hyderabad Adventure Club and The Society, the Rockathon was supported by Telangana Tourism and flagged off by Shri Jayesh Ranjan, Principal Secretary Industries & Commerce and Information Technology Department, Government of Telangana.

As always the crowd pullers were the rappelling and ziplining events with rock walks, slack lining, games, rock quiz and rock shot put making up for the rest. The Snake Demo by the Friends of Snakes held the rapt attention of the onlookers and many a myth about snakes were dispelled. The Society hopes to participate this year too like in previous years. Please lookout for details on our website after 15th January.


27th Anniversary
